

ELECTIONS UPDATE

Elections were held in September 2022 for Districts 1 and 2 for Chiropodists, and Combined District 1 for Podiatrists. Chad Bezaire, Chiropodist, was elected in District 2, Matthew Andrade, Chiropodist, was acclaimed in District 1, and Peter Stavropoulos, Podiatrist, was acclaimed in combined District 1.
