# **Bylaw Amendment Consultation**

At its June 25, 2021 meeting, Council passed two bylaws in principle that were circulated to the membership for consultation via email. Please provide your input by emailing <u>consultations@cocoo.on.ca</u> by August 29, 2021. Council will consider the input it receives and vote on the bylaws at its next meeting on October 29, 2021.

The first is an amendment for an increase of \$100 to the annual fees members pay. The second is an amendment for an annual adjustment to reflect the cost of

living increase each year based on the consumer price index. This increase would take effect in 2023.

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## **Registration Exam Update**

The 2020 Supplemental OSCE is being combined with the 2021 main OSCE and will be held on Saturday, August 21, 2021, at the Michener Institute.

The 2021 written examination took place on Saturday, June 26, 2021, and was carried out online for the first time. We are happy to report that the system worked perfectly, and the Standard Setting for the written portion of the exam is underway.



# **ICRC & Discipline Committee Update**

In the first half of 2021, the College received 16 complaints, opened three Registrar's investigations, and received one referral from the Quality Assurance Committee. These numbers are consistent with last year. By comparison, in the first half of 2020, the College received 18 complaints and opened one Registrar's investigation...

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# Human Rights Code

COVID-19 has highlighted several human rights issues that panels of the ICRC have considered.

As a reminder, members of the College are required to abide by the Ontario Human Rights Code (the "Code"). In fact, compliance with the Code is embedded in the College's *Patient Relations* standard. Members who have questions or concerns about compliance with the Code are encouraged to seek legal advice.



# Recruitment of College Mentors & Practice Assessors

The College is continuing to recruit mentors (also called "Supervisors" or "Educators") to be added to its roster. Mentors are assigned to perform site visits and work with members to ensure that they meet the College's standards after the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee ("ICRC") orders a Specified Continuing Education or Remediation Program ("SCERP") or the Discipline Committee orders supervision of the member's practice...
