## Members providing essential/emergency care in the community during the COVID -19 Pandemic.

<ul> <li>Using Professional Clinical Judgement to determine what Essential / Emergency Care is in your Practice Population.</li> <li>Evaluate Ability to meet IPAC Recommendations for use of Personal Protective Equipment.         <ul> <li>Care of Individuals with Suspect or Confirmed Covid-19 (Airborne, Droplet and Contact Precautions),</li> <li>Care of Covid-19 Negative Individuals (Droplet and Contact Precautions)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Members are strongly advised to self-assess daily using <i>Ontario Public Health (PHO) Self Assessment Tool</i></li> <li>IDENTIFY Suspected COVID-19 cases by following current PHO protocol and tools to determine next steps. Screen patients THREE TIMES for COVID-19 using the PHO protocol and tools</li> <li>BY PHONE - Take patient through the self-assessment tool. If the patient screens positive at any SCREENING STAGE they should be instructed to stay home, self quarantine and not be given an appointment. Advise to contact Public health</li> <li>AT THE DOOR – Signage</li> <li>AT RECEPTION- Guide patient through the self-assessment tool (maintain spatial distance of at least 2 m and/or separation by physical barrier and or Droplet and Contact precautions</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Provide <u>ON</u> required for</li> <li>Schedule p waiting /co distancing.</li> <li>REQUEST the family men unless esset</li> <li>Place paties as soon as</li> </ul>

Instruct to go home, self quarantine. Advise to contact Public Health for next steps. Thoroughly follow ALL Infection control procedures.
